### **GECC Panel Updates**

  - Please pay particular attention to new criteria information in the GECC Communication panel document for writing in the composition courses. The new information is included on page 3 of the document under "Assignments" and the subsection of "Writing Assignments."
- There was a special meeting in September that allowed some of the GECC panels to review and revise their descriptions. The panel affected are the Humanities and Fine Arts panel, the Life Sciences panel, and the Social and Behavioral Sciences panel. The Humanities and Fine Arts panel continue their work of revising their many courses. However, changes to the Life the Sciences panel descriptors as well has the Social and Behavioral Sciences panel descriptors are live on the site. The changes to descriptions for these two panels are effective for the spring 2018 semester.
- New description(s) for Geography in the GECC Social and Behavioral Sciences have been created. Please feel free to submit courses to the new World Geography descriptor.
   If you have a course in the Human Geography description and feel it would be a better match for the new description, please submit it for approval to the panel.
- The prerequisite for some of the GECC Mathematics courses have changed. Please review the course descriptions for M1901, M1902, M1904, and M1907 for information on the new prerequisite for these courses.
