Get Ready to Submit Your Courses!

ICCB and iTransfer are streamlining the course submission process to decrease the time you wait for courses to be posted and reviewed. When you post

your courses and upload supporting documents to our user-friendly **Course Submission system**, we can process and post them to WebReview very quickly.

The system puts the courses directly into our database, saving a great deal of staff time on data entry. Also, the system will update you on the progress of your courses by email, including when the course is posted to **WebReview**.

We are no longer accepting courses by email or any other means. If you do not submit your courses using the online system, you will be asked to resubmit the course and supporting documents using the online system. We are also asking you to aim for February 15 and September 15 instead of March 1 and October 1. We will still accept courses through the normal deadlines, but submitting them earlier will give staff sufficient time to process the courses and get the materials to the panels for review. Panel meetings are more efficient when members can review the courses in advance of the meetings.
