NOTES:

All Design fields and most BFA Studio programs require a second semester portfolio review prior to being admitted to the degree program. Demonstrated proficiency and specific grade point averages may be required. Most course work will be accepted but additional work to strengthen the portfolio may be required prior to admission thus delaying the time to degree completion. Students are strongly encouraged to contact their preference of transfer institution prior to their sophomore year for specific admission advice.

Art Education degree requirements are established by the transfer institution and the State of Illinois. The curriculum is very time and sequence specific so students are strongly encouraged to consult the transfer institution of choice prior to their freshman year at a community college. Failure to do so may extend time to graduation unnecessarily.

All art majors are being encouraged, or required (depending on major), to meet grade point minima for continuation in their major programs. These vary from program to program. Please consult the transfer institution for specifics.
