During the first semester at WIU, candidates must complete the Technology Competency Assessment (TCA) and an Illinois/FBI fingerprint background investigation. Students are required to be fully accepted into the teacher education program by the start of the second semester in order to enroll/continue in the sequence of courses.

A grade of “C” or better is required in all 3-400 level education courses. See catalog.

Individuals having difficulty with passing any state test may be required to take additional course work.

Any course substitutions and/or waivers will not be made until the candidate is fully accepted to the teacher education program.

Candidates wishing to pursue dual certification in ELED will need a minimum of two additional semesters of course work. Dual certification is not part of the AAT agreement.
