



Northeastern Illinois University UPDATES.....

Total enrollment for Fall 2009 was 11, 631. This represent a 3.9% increase from the prior fall; total FTE (full time enrollment) also increased by 5.3%

New transfer students were up 24% from Fall 2008 (from 1, 127 to 1, 398)

The Spring 2010 semester admission deadline for all degree seeking students and non degree seeking students has been extended to December 1, 2009; both on-line and paper application. This does not include international students

As of July 2009, we require only 24 semester hours with minimum cumulative gpa of 2.0 for admission for transfer students

Transfer students who completed 24 or more semester hours who were academically dismissed from a college or university, or have a cumulative grade point average below 2.0, but have been out of school for at least one academic year (including summer), will be admitted without need for formal appeal

College of Business and Management at NEIU is re-evaluating business law courses from all the community colleges. As of now these courses will transfer into NEIU as elective.

We have new Title V joint grant with College of Lake County and Northeastern Illinois University to better serve our transfer population. We will hire an Articulation Specialist to create transfer guides for the various community colleges by academic program. Also, in the next year or so, we will have a new Admissions and Transfer Center at NEIU, with increased collaboration with College of Lake County

The Illinois State Legislature has approved funding for a new College of Education Building
